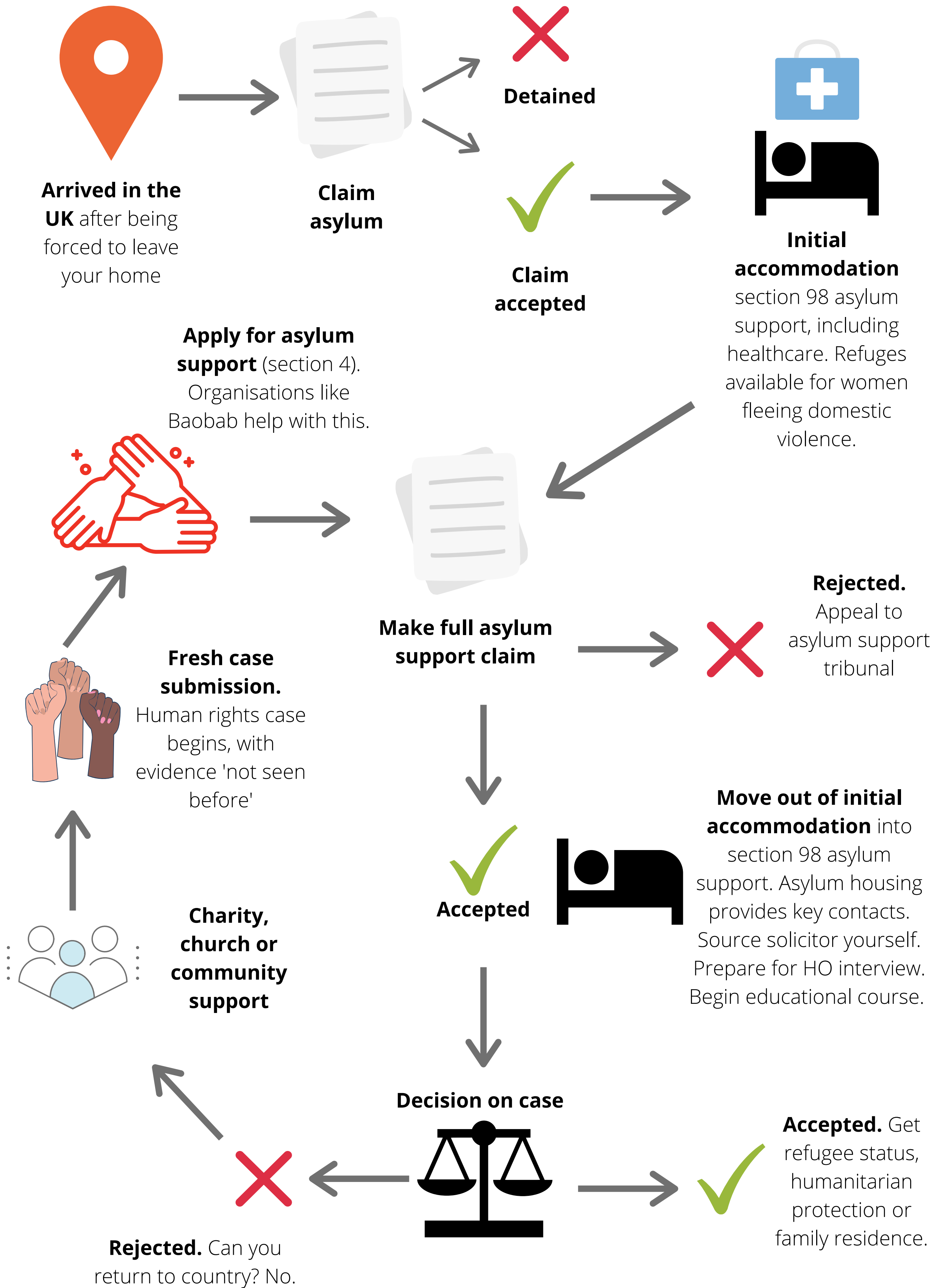

**Arrived in the UK** after being forced to leave your home



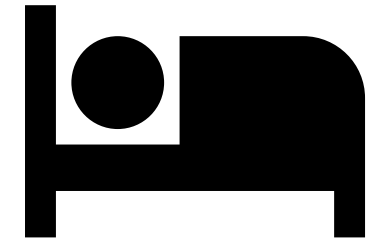
**Claim asylum**

section 98 asylum support, including healthcare. Refugees available for women fleeing domestic violence.

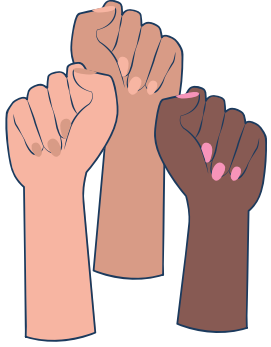
**Apply for asylum support** (section 4). Organisations like Baobab help with this.



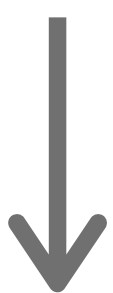
**Make full asylum support claim**



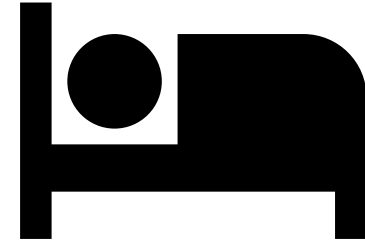
**Rejected.** Appeal to asylum support tribunal



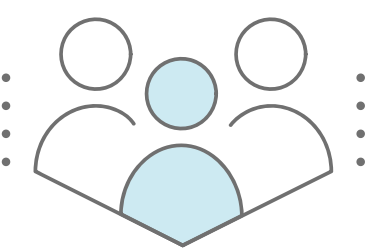
**Fresh case submission.** Human rights case begins, with evidence 'not seen before'



**Accepted**



**Move out of initial accommodation** into section 98 asylum support. Asylum housing provides key contacts. Source solicitor yourself. Prepare for HO interview. Begin educational course.



**Charity, church or community support**

**Decision on case**



**Rejected.** Can you return to country? No.



**Accepted.** Get refugee status, humanitarian protection or family residence.
